

What is the Racial Equity Fund?

- The United Way for Southeastern Michigan has secured \$200,000 to support Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC)-led organizations through the MacKenzie Scott Fund.
- The **Racial Equity Fund (REF)** is designed to provide financial support for these organizations and their programs and projects that work toward eliminating racial disparities in pursuit of a more equitable and just community for all.
- Informed by community-led workgroup in 2021 & 2023
 - Capacity building & sustainability; unrestricted grant dollars
 - Workgroup impact affecting UWSEM enterprisewide



United Way for Southeastern Michigan

The Racial Equity Fund: 2024

- \$200,000 Million available in flexible, unrestricted funding
- Organizations must have BIPOC executive leadership
- Organizations must be based in and serve residents of Washtenaw County
- Organizations should respond to and mitigate the effects of racial inequities and/or build power and infrastructure in communities of color across Washtenaw County



United Way for Southeastern Michigan

The Racial Equity Fund: Eligibility Criteria

- Funding Range: \$10,000 \$50,000
- Funding Period: 12-months (January December 2024)
- Competitive RFP open to new partners
- Must be a 501(c)3 or working with a fiduciary that is a 501(c)(3)
- Based in Washtenaw County AND serve Washtenaw County residents
- Organizations must have BIPOC executive leadership
- Organizations with established programs/services in the funding categories

The Racial Equity Fund: Funding Priorities

- Basic needs, health and/or crisis
 - Living Wage
 - Food Security
 - Housing
 - Racial Health Disparities
 - Mass Incarceration
- Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion
 - Rest, rejuvenation, & healing for nonprofit leaders & staff
 - DEI Skill-Building

- Economic Mobility
 - Programing to support BIPOCowned businesses
 - Employment/skilled trade
- Environmental Justice
 - Climate Change
 - Pollution
 - Clean Water, Food, & Air
- Open Category

The Racial Equity Fund: Scoring Rubric

View Scoring Rubric

- Applications scored across seven categories. 100 total points possible.
- Program Narrative: Addressing Racial Inequities
- Program Narrative: Success & Impact
- Milestones
- Metrics
- Community Voice
- Budget
- Overall Application Integrity

The Racial Equity Fund: Evaluation Process

- All applications are reviewed by a minimum of three reviewers, including United Way staff members and external volunteers.
- Recommendations are presented to leadership for their approval.
- Investment decisions are made based on a variety of criteria, including but not limited to the scoring rubric, geographic scope, gaps in services and client population, all of which are used to identify organizations that have the capability to create the most impact both individually and collectively for Washtenaw County.
- Awards may be less than the amount for which an organization has applied. These decisions are made based on the strength of the application, proposed services, and geographic spread, among other considerations including United Way's overall budget for this RFP and the full portfolio of partners.




Accessing Grant Applications: Switch to Organizational View






Accessing Grant Applications: Select Programs






