

Connecting people to services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, 2-1-1 is a human-centered information and referral system that provides barrier free and confidential access to help by phone, text, e-mail and chat. Our team of community care advocates serves as a lifeline for members of our community, helping connect callers to local resources, programs and services that can help them navigate a crisis and get back on to a thriving, self-sufficient path. Donor support funds more than 50% of 2-1-1's annual cost and has allowed us to:
